5. Marshes and wet polder grasslands around Damme

• The wet grasslands near Damme are part of the larger polder area along the Belgian coast. Tidal flats and marshes, part of the former Zwin estuary, have been embanked gradually over several centuries and been used since as grazing land. Intensification of the agriculture in the last decades increased the pressure to drain these grasslands and convert them to arable land. Around the small city of Damme, the grasslands Natuurpunt was able to protect many of these grasslands and now several projects are implemented to return to a more nature oriented water management. During this excursion the different habitats will be visited, and attention will be given to the problems of water and nature management.

We combine this visit with a guided biking tour from the city center of Bruges along the typical Polder landscape to Damme.
